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SUMMER CHALLENGE: SPREAD THE WORD

World of God set an ambitious goal for 2017 - to find sponsors for 156 additional children (20% increase). The spring season has brought great momentum which we would like to continue into summer. We need your help to spread the word about this opportunity to touch the life of a child in Haiti. Below are 10 simple ways to spread the word.

1. Share our child of the month through Facebook. It takes 2 seconds to hit the share button. Make the share even more powerful by sharing your experience as a sponsor.
2. Present the idea of an individual or group sponsorship to your Small Group, Mom's Group, Sunday School Class or other groups.
3. Pick one friend a week to share your experience of sponsorship. Ask them to consider becoming a sponsor.
4. Have a BBQ, Ice Cream Party, Pool Party or other summer gathering for friends and neighbors. Share your personal story of sponsorship and/or mission trips. Ask them to join you as a sponsor or on your church's next trip. (World of God can provide information for you to use)
5. Host a sponsorship table at your church's Vacation Bible School or other summer camps drop-off and pick-up locations. (World of God is happy to provide supplies and volunteers for this.)
6. Ask your favorite restaurant to hold a benefit night for OFCB Ministries in Haiti. Share information about sponsorship and relationship based missions.
7. Send one email a week sharing your experience with a friend who you think could become a sponsor
8. Create a lemonade or ice pop stand with your kids this summer to support OFCB Ministries; give information about sponsorship with each purchase.
9. Share the monthly newsletter with a different friend each month.
10. Share your celebrations this summer. Purchase a gift for Bayonnais for your loved ones and we will send them a card. This is a easy no-risk outreach tool.
